Benefits of Selling Tax Liens

- Bring new revenue to your budget by accessing your accounts receivable.
- In subsequent years your revenue should equal or exceed your budgeted amount.
- The collection process remains unchanged.
- The taxing district retains control over the liens.
- The purchaser (MRS) does not collect taxes.
- The relationship between the tax collector and taxpayer remains unchanged.
- Helps to prevent slumlords from accumulating more distressed property.

MRS Patented Program Enables the Sale of Real Estate Tax Claims Across PA

- MRS has been providing this service since 2004 and has provided in excess of \$500 million in new money to taxing authorities across Pennsylvania.
- A taxing entity (i.e. City, County or School District) sells its delinquent real estate tax claims to a public entity (i.e., a Redevelopment Authority, a non-profit or a Land Bank) which acts as a conduit purchaser.
- MRS does not collect the taxes. The taxing authority's current collection system remains intact. The existing delinquent tax collector collects the taxes as they are required to do and then remits the funds collected to the purchaser.
- There is no interruption to the statutory operations of the delinquent tax collectors.
- This transaction does not create debt; it is a true sale under GASB 48 and pursuant to an opinion by the PA DCED.
- After the Taxing Authority adopts an Ordinance or Resolution authorizing the sale, closing can take place within 30 days.
- The purchaser is able to pay up front 90% of the face amount of the tax liens for the four most recent fiscal years to the Taxing Authority.
- The total cost of the transaction is borne by the purchaser with fees and expenses included in the finance structure.
- This Tax Lien Management Program is designed to be evergreen and renew annually, although the Taxing Authority is in no way ever required to sell its delinquent real estate tax liens.
- The Taxing Authority will receive an immediate source of revenue up front which can be incorporated into the current annual budget.
- The third-party purchaser purchases all tax liens for security interest purposes. The tax lien portfolio includes defined non-qualifying liens and chronic liens that have a zero value. These are included to simplify record keeping and to maintain integrity in the liens from oldest to newest on each parcel for controlling the security interest in the lien.
